The Conference shall begin promptly at **10:30 a.m.** and shall be held at the job location Greer Park (by the parking lot area), 1098 Amarillo Avenue, Palo Alto, CA. **The Conference is not mandatory.** All prospective Bidders are encouraged to attend.

The Contract Documents, including instructions to bidders, drawings, technical specifications and bid forms, may be obtained from or examined at the Purchasing Office. There is a non-refundable fee of **\$52.00** for the plans and specifications for this project. A general description of work is as follows:

The work to be performed, in general, consists of furnishing all labor, tools, equipment, materials, and transportation required to perform the Greer Park Renovation and Pump Station Replacement. Work under contract includes, but not limited to, mobilization, demolition, grading & drainage, decomposed granite paving, asphalt pavement, unit masonry, metal gates, chain link fencing, site furnishings, play equipment, irrigation, landscape soil preparation, overseeding, planting, landscape maintenance, site concrete, wood screen fence, pump station replacement and site electrical, including all incidental and related work as required by the General Requirements, Specifications, and Drawings in the Invitation for Bids (IFB) available upon request. Bid Submittal:

Bids must be submitted on the bid form provided by the City of Palo Alto. Bids of \$25,000 or greater must be accompanied by bidder's security (Bid Bond) in the amount of 10% of the bid amount.

The Bidder to whom the Contract will be awarded must, at the time of bid submittal, possess current licenses in the following classification issued by the California State Contractors License Board: **Class-A (General Engineering)**. Bidder's subcontractors must also be properly licensed.
