

INDUSTRIAL WASTE ENFORCEMENT

In 1989, the Regional Water Quality Control Plant (RWQCP) began implementing enforcement procedures designed to impose monetary penalties. Enforcement since, has resulted in compliance agreements with industries that violated their discharge limits. Fewer agreements have been needed in recent years due in part to increased awareness about the potential for penalties and better compliance rates. In most cases, the agreements require both monetary penalties and the implementation of corrective measures identified through pollutant source reduction studies.

The table below outlines monetary penalties received for violations in 1997.
