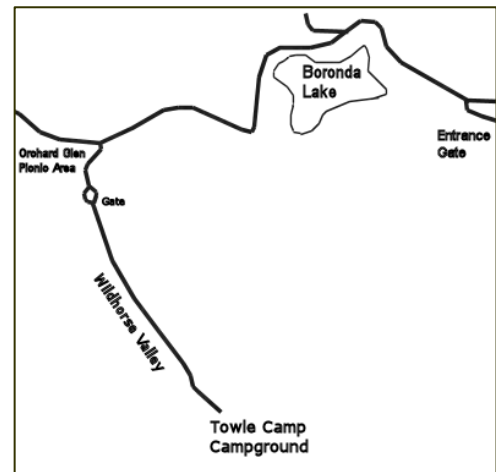

## What is Towle Camp?

Towle Camp is Foothills Parks' Campground. Located at the end of Wildhorse Valley in Foothills Park, the campground is open every night from May 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup>.

There are eight tent camping sites. Sites 1 and 5 hold 16 people each (in up to 4 cars) while the other sites hold 8 people each (in up to 2 cars). Each site has a tent / sleeping area, picnic table, charcoal barbeque, food locker, and water. In addition there are two-group campfire circles with benches and portable toilets located in the parking lot.



## How can I reserve a campsite?

Campsites can be reserved up to one year in advance. Many Friday and Saturday nights are booked two to four months in advance. Sunday through Thursday nights are often available that same week.

Reservation applications are accepted on a first come, first served basis, at the time we process the application with payment. You must be a Palo Alto resident to make a reservation and only residents and accompanied guest can enter Foothills Park.

Rental applications are also available by mail or in person at the main counter at Lucie Stern Community Centers during regular business hours. The applications can also be mailed or faxed from Foothills Park.

Reservations can be made up to one year in advance, but must be made at least 24 hours in advance at Lucie Stern. For same day reservations or more information please call Foothills Park at 329-2423.

Fees: Friday & Saturday nights are \$26.00 per site each night. Sunday through Thursday nights are \$15.00 per site. Group reservations of 4 or more sites on any night are \$26.00 per site.

## Important things to know

**Wildlife:** Foothills Park has lots of wildlife. Each campsite has a food storage locker to protect non-perishable food. Ice chests should be locked in vehicles at night.

**Fires:** Please bring charcoal for the above ground barbeques (Do not burn wood in BBQs). Wood or charcoal may be burned in the two campfire circles. Please help us protect the local ecosystem by bringing in your own firewood. Foothills Park is a high fire danger area. A daily fire permit is required and will be issued when you check into your campsite. During high fire danger, fires may be restricted or prohibited.

**R.V.'s Prohibited:** As Towle Camp is a tent campground only; the parking area is restricted to passenger vehicles and small trucks. Recreational vehicles, trailers or other self-contained vehicles (regardless of size, weight or number of axles) are not allowed in the Towle Campground parking lot, or Wildhorse Valley.

**Dogs:** Dogs are not permitted in Foothills Park on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays. Because of this restriction, dogs are not permitted in Towle Camp on evenings before holidays and on Friday nights. For the safety of your pet and park wildlife, dogs must be leashed and physically restrained at all times.
