CalPERS deducts the full medical premium from Retiree's pension amount, less the City's minimum contribution. Outside reimbursement administrator issues a check/direct deposit to reimburse Retiree on a monthly basis. CalPERS Retiree (warrant) check is deposited and paid to Retiree on a monthly basis.

### **End of Year Process:**

- 1) Reimbursement administrator will mail substantiation form to retiree.
- 2) Complete substantiation form and mail to reimbursement administrator directly.

## **City Share of Healthcare Premium**

#### **Retiree Health Benefit:**

Retiree health benefit levels are negotiated in labor agreements. Currently, labor agreements break down retiree medical benefits by groups according to the hire date, retirement date, and employee group at the time of retirement. Contracting agencies are required to provide an employer health contribution toward the cost of the monthly premium for all eligible employees and annuitants.
