

For the past 5 years I have been the Manager of Sustainabiliy and Energy Programs for the county and have learned alot about energy efficiency issues and the challenges of planning for change. For the past 15 years I have been on the Board of my Homeowners Association, currently serving as President of Palo Alto Redwoods, and I have a great deal of experience in common interest development governance. In my heart and soul I am a health educator who has found many ways to motivate people to make behavior changes that are beneficial. And perhaps my proudest accomplishment was acting as my mothe r's advocate, keeping her in her home until age 97 and overseeing her care until her death at 103. I have been an affordable housing advocate and a member of Peninsula Interfaith Action for ~ 15 years. I am an active member of the Palo Alto Unitarian Universalist Church. Many Palo Alto City Hall issues have captured my attention, including recently the Maybell proposed Sr. housing, which I strongly supported.

When I voted in the most recent City Council Election, I read all the candidate statements to see who mentioned our regional jobs housing imbalance. I am a strong and unapologetic supporter of market rate and affordable housing. I am also practical and curious about how zoning and policy all "adds up". What are the regional pressures and reality? What are the fiscal impacts of zoning decisions. I am an ecologist (Ph.D. Ecology, UC Davis) and the mother of a developmentally disabled adult. My personal and professional experience has directed my civic engagement. For over a decade, I focused on the questions of - how do we care for disabled members of our community, and how do we include and sustain natural resources in our future. As a volunteer and through my job, I participated in community advisory groups and task forces aimed to benefit developmentally disabled people and to improve land use, planning and development projects. I am employed with the Santa Clara Valley Audubon Society (an organization with 500 members in Palo Alto), and volunteer with the Loma Prieta Chapter of the Sierra Club as the co-chair of the Wildlife Committee. I frequently communicate and collaborate with other local environmental groups, including Acterra's Watershed Stewardship program, the Committee for Green Foothills, and the California Native Plant Society. I am one of two moderators for the Conservation Council, a group of conservation leaders and representatives of 12 environmental organizations in the region who meet monthly to discuss and coordinate environmental action on proposed policy and projects. With focus on protection of nature and integration of biological assets into our urban environment. I participate, contribute and influence projects and planning processes in Cities and Government Agencies throughout Santa Clara County, I also work with local companies to protect and enhance nature in their campuses. In Palo Alto, I have attended public meetings on the Palo Alto Comprehensive Plan update since 2012 and have previously provided input on the Plan's Natural and Urban Environment and Safety Element. Often, I was one of a handful of people in the audience as the Planning commission discussed the Plan update. Recently, I attended meetings of the Comprehensive Plan Leadership Group and the Our Palo Alto Summit event. I occasionally communicate t hrough the media. Guest Opinions that I authored or coauthored have been published in the Daily Post (Adobe Creek Crossing, March 2015) Palo Alto Weekly (Searsville Dam, May 2015), the San Jose Mercury News (Bird Friendly Building Design, July 2014). I served on the Community Advisory Committee for Special Education for the Palo Alto Unified School District, with focus Transition Planning (2009-2010). I am a former board member of the Housing Choices Coalition (an organization that started in Palo Alto), an organization dedicated to finding housing solutions for developmentally

disabled adults. I served as community member for the San Andreas Regional Center (SARC) sub-committee on Housing as a part of a 2010 California Senate Select Committee work group on housing for autistic adults. SARC serves many families in Palo Alto. I served on additional task forces and Community advisory committees, including the Searsville Alternatives Study Advisory Group, the Palo Alto Energy/Comp ost Facility or Export Option Community Review Group, and the Santa Clara Valley Water District Independent Monitoring Committee for the first Measure B. I am a Fish and Game Commissioner for Santa Clara County. I actively participate in Adobe Meadows neighborhood community meetings.

I came to Palo Alto in 1997 and with my husband, purchased a small house with a large yard on Corina Way. My husband is a software engineer, born and raised in the US, and he immediately loved living here. For me - an immigrant adjustment was not immediate. Early on, I spend a lot of time in our yard planting fruit trees and a vegetable garden, and caring for hens. I also hiked and learned to appreciate the spectacular natural setting of Palo Alto and its parks and open space. I took care of my very special child, and learned to appreciate the support that the community offered. And I made friends. But years passed before I became a citizen and before I understood American democracy. Years passed before I developed a true sense of place and a true connection to Palo Alto, its people and its landscapes. Years passed before I found the courage to speak publicly about issues related to disabilities, and to our natural environment. But when I finally spoke, I realized that people I isten, and that I can make a difference. I hope to continue making a difference. I believe that I can bring a unique and inclusive perspective to the Palo Alto Comprehensive Plan Community Advisory Committee. Our city is moving into challenging times, as we strive to sustainably embrace more people in the community, and to allow for diversity of origins. incomes and fortunes. Our natural and urban landscape must keep up with regulatory impositions and adapt to climate change and seal level rise. Looking at a city's future requires that one takes a holistic view, and I hope that I can help widen the spectrum as Palo Alto crafts a blueprint to guide us through 2030.

if you are looking for people with significant prior Palo Alto community voluntarism and participation, I am afraid I will not fit the bill, though I have participated in some Bay Area groups on a voluntary basis: specifically, teaching a class to a Citizen Schools after school program, and working with South Bay youth in the Green Kids program. As a Senior Educational Researcher at SRI International in Menio Park, I have worked with some teachers at Gunn under a National Science Foundation funded project that I led which introduced innovative uses of regional California geospatial scientific data in high school science classes. This was part of a broader agenda around conceptualizing what characterizes the challenges of building community resilience to environmental change and how to educate students and the broad public about those challenges.
