
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**SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT OF FIVE ADDITIONAL MEMBERS TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

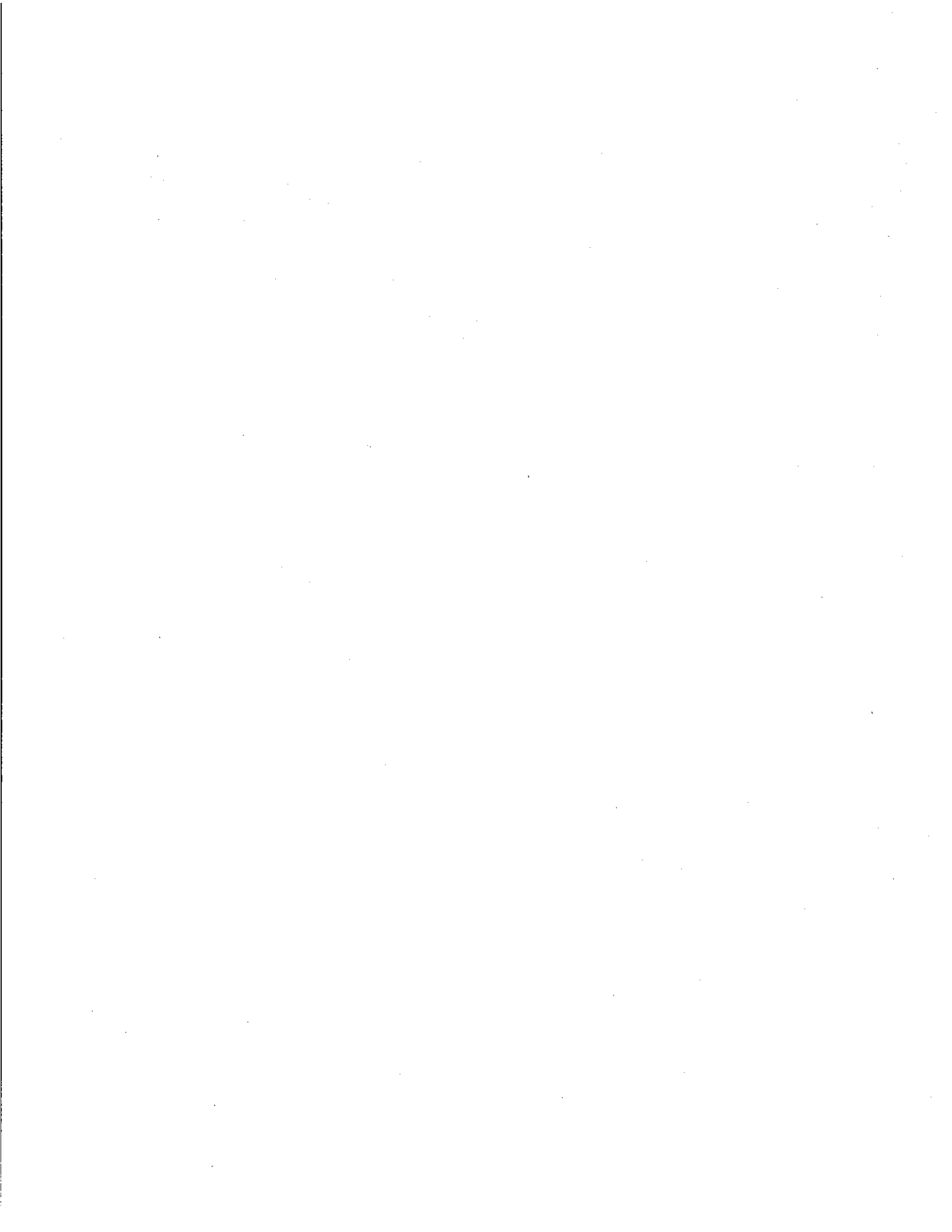

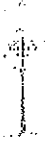

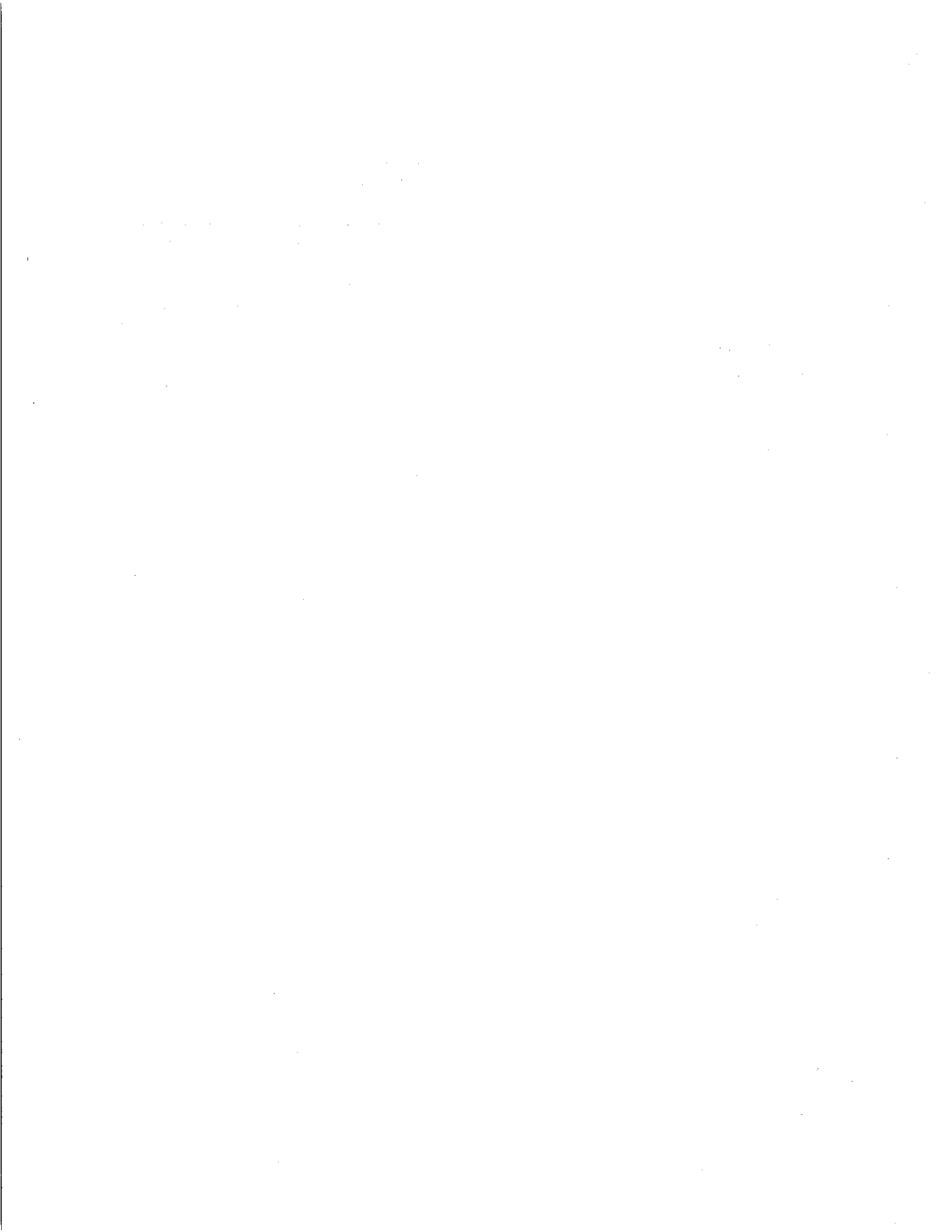
Why are you interested in serving on the Citizens Advisory Committee?:

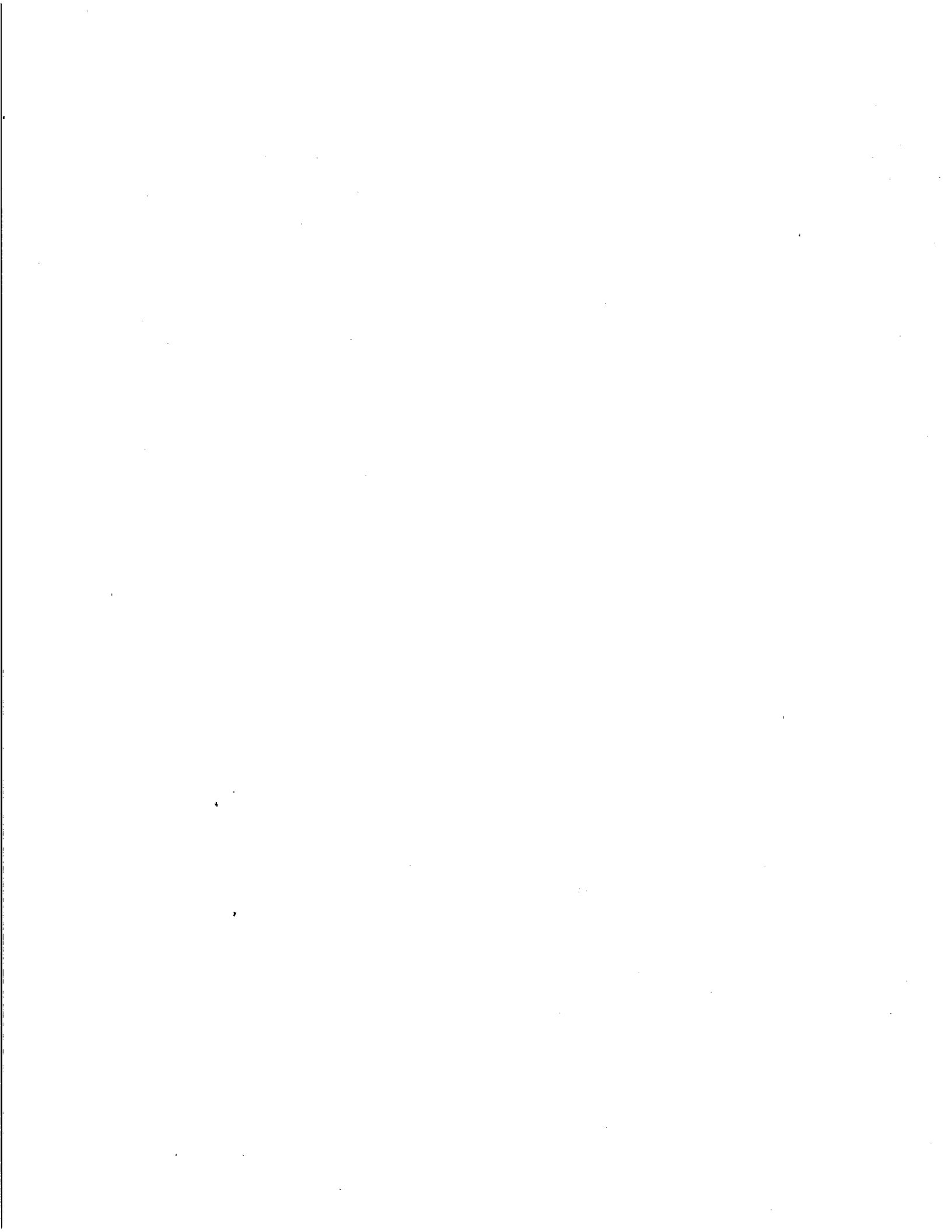

If you are looking for people with significant prior Palo Alto community voluntarism and participation, I am afraid I will not fit the bill, though I have participated in some Bay Area groups on a voluntary basis: specifically, teaching a class to a Citizen Schools after school program, and working with South Bay youth in the Green Kids program. As a Senior Educational Researcher at SRI International in Menlo Park, I have worked with some teachers at Gunn under a National Science Foundation funded project that I led which introduced innovative uses of regional California geospatial scientific data in high school science classes. This was part of a broader agenda around conceptualizing what characterizes the challenges of building community resilience to environmental change and how to educate students and the broad public about those challenges. I've written curricula and papers on this (see my work at sis.sri.com).

Answer to Question 2:

I have lived in midtown Palo Alto as a resident since 1990. Before that, I lived in Palo Alto rentals while attending graduate school at Stanford. My two children have gone through the school system, starting at Ohlone and through Gunn. After a long and busy career, what motivates me to serve on the Committee is to make a contribution to the betterment of Palo Alto in the critical issues that were discussed at the recent Saturday community meeting.
