	1. DISCUSSION OF DRAFT MOU FOR PROJECT SAFETY NET
46 17	Commissioner Bacchetti provided background information. He explained that the draft MOU he
47 48	prepared is realistic as to what the HRC can expect to accomplish. He also provided a handout of the

survey results from Palo Alto kids as backup information. He summarized the draft MOU by saying that

it had seven bullet points which cover what the HRC intends to do and a statement on the back which explains that the Human Services Needs Assessment is expected to take up most of the commissioners time. He asked for comments and said that he would like it approved tonight, if possible. He announced that Project Safety Net received the Helen Putnam Award from the League of Cities. Ms. van der Zwaag invited the commissioners to participate in "Gate Keeper" training. The commissioners discussed the draft MOU and the importance of the commissioners being champions to assist with the work and the agreements on the MOU. Staff was asked to look into including the "Asset of the Month" on future agendas.

#### 2. FINALIZE NEW HRC PRIORITIES FOR 2011-2012

The commissioners discussed and finalized their priorities with no changes. Staff was asked to look into the possibility of occasionally holding meetings at other venues as a way to encourage participation and civic engagement.

## 3. UPDATE ON HUMAN SERVICES NEEDS ASSESSMENT

Commissioner O'Nan reported that the subcommittee is continuing to make progress on the Needs Assessment. On October 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> they have setup a meeting with the current HSRAP recipients in an effort to gather information. She also reported that she has been working with staff to refine the questions that will be asked, the tools and training that will be needed for this and future stakeholder meetings.

 Ms. van der Zwaag commented that in an effort to ease any anxiety the commissioners may have about leading focus group sessions, they are welcome to attend the first two scheduled that were previously mentioned. as a demonstration, because she will be leading them. She said that she will be creating tool kits for each focus group meeting that will everything needed. She passed around a sign-up sheet for focus group meetings and stakeholder interviews.

Councilmember Price suggested that notes be prepared immediately following each meeting that can be used as a tool for improving future meetings.

### 4. DISCUSSION TO ORGANIZE A LOCAL AREA HRC BREAKFAST

Commissioner Ezran mentioned that for the last two years City of Palo Alto HRC has been invited to attend a breakfast meeting hosted by City of Mountain View's HRC. It has been mentioned that the City of Palo Alto's HRC might host the next one.

 Commissioner O'Nan reported that she can get the list of invitees from the Staff Liaison for Mountain View HRC and that in a previous conversation she was told the expenses have been minimal. There was a brief discussion about staff support for this if the commissioners agree to host a future breakfast. Ms. van der Zwaag said that can commit staff to helping out if an HRC subcommittee is setup. There was a discussion about having structure and content planned for the meeting so that it is substantive and not just a social gathering. Commissioner Bernardo said she will look into hosting the event, but will need to confirm this later. Commissioners Ezran, Bernardo, Verma and O'Nan agreed to be on a subcommittee to plan the event.
