CPR & First Aid Certification

Course Description

CPRescue provides this Pediatric CPR and First Aid course in a three-part hybrid format to comply with county and state regulations. CPRescue trainers are approved by the California Emergency Medical Services Authority (EMSA) to teach childcare licensed CPR classes.

Skills Covered:

- Responsiveness Assessment
- CPR (one rescuer)
- Control of Bleeding
- Managing Shock

- Assessing Airway, Breathing and Circulation (ABC's)
- Clearing and Protecting the Airway
- Illness Assessment and Treatments
- Injury Assessments and Treatments

Part A (CPR): To be completed online 1-2 weeks prior to Part C Part B (First Aid): To be completed online 1-2 weeks prior to Part C Part C (Skills Test): To be completed in-person at the PACCC Main Office

Students will receive an email at least 1 week in advance with their assigned time slot for Part C; 8:00 - 9:30am, 9:30 - 11:00am, or 11:00-12:30pm. Groups will consist of 10 students or less. Students will not come in contact with each other and skills will not be demonstrated person-toperson.
