Reservation Rules and Conditions

- Reservations must be completed and paid at least four (4) weeks before the program date and may be made up to 3 months in advance (with the exception of Get Married By a Ranger program, which may have a longer lead time).
- Any reservation made less than four (4) weeks before the event date will be subject to an additional fee of \$75.00 and is entirely contingent on existing staff availability.
- For programs held in Foothills Park, reservation requests must be made by a Palo Alto resident who must attend the event.
- All residency rules apply for events held in Foothills Park. A guest list must be received at least one week before the program.
- All programs must end (including cleanup) no later than one half hour before preserve closing time. See http://www.cityofpaloalto.org/civicax/filebank/documents/30309/ for hours.
- Unless otherwise specified this is not a facility use application. Facility use applications must be made separately (e.g., camping or picnic area reservations, special use permits).
- No reservation for a program is confirmed until the application is signed by the applicant, returned with payment, and approved by Open Space staff.
- Programs are designed for a maximum attendance of 25 people unless otherwise noted. Groups of 26-50 require one (1) additional ranger. Each additional staff member costs \$75 per hour. The ranger will discuss this with you before approving your application. Groups of more than 50 cannot be accommodated.
- All Palo Alto Open Space rules, regulations and applicable municipal code sections apply during the program. They may be found online on the City of Palo Alto's website (www.cityofpaloalto.org/openspace, then click the Rules and Regulations link on the left). Anyone in violation of preserve rules and regulations or the municipal code is liable for citation and ejection from Open Space.

Cancellation Policy

- If you must cancel your event, a fee of 1/3 of the program cost will be assessed and the remainder will be refunded. Notice of cancellation must be given in writing at least one (1) week in advance.
- Any outdoor program may be rescheduled or cancelled by you on short notice due to inclement weather. Campfire programs may be cancelled, at Open Space staff discretion, during times of high fire danger or if the fire is determined to be of an unsafe size. Weather or high fire danger cancellations will be refunded in full.
- Palo Alto Park rangers are on-duty first responders. During an emergency, staff assigned to a program may be unavailable without notice. If this happens, the program will be cancelled for that date. Cancelled programs may be rescheduled or cancelled (with a full refund of fees) at the applicant's option.
