I will be the first one to speak up about the trauma my daughter and our family has endured and the lifelong scars she has on her neck and face from the attack - some scars from the knife and other from the attacker's fingernails. I would never want this, or something worse, to happen to any of your families in the name of "charity." If the church is worried about homelessness and wants to be charitable, then the church can expend its funds and services another way.
