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Application for Permit – Temporary Street Closure (Class B) Neighborhood Block Party. (PAMC 10.10.010)

The Palo Alto Police Department must receive completed applications at least ten (10) days in advance of the scheduled date of closure.

Class B- Temporary Street Closure, defined:

A block party or similar occurrence not exceeding one city block on other than arterial or collector streets, and along which at least two-thirds of the area is in a residential zone, and to which a majority of owners, residents or tenants of properties fronting such area consent, which is sponsered solely by residents, tenants or owners, and is not for commercial or advertising purposes or profit shall be designated Class B.
