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## PRIOR TO FINAL SIGN-OFF OF THE BUILDING PERMIT:

- Submit final Flood Emergency Operation Plan to Public Works Engineering.
- Submit final Flood Proofing Inspection & Maintenance Plan to Public Works Engineering.
- Owner shall sign and record a covenant stating that the Flood Emergency Operation
  Plan and the Flood Proofing Inspection & Maintenance Plan will be followed for the
  life of the structure and that the agreement shall be transferred to all subsequent
  owners.
- This Project shall file a Floodproofing Certificate for Non-Residential Structures (FEMA Form FF-206-FY-22-153) with all applicable authorities. The Floodproofing Certificate shall include the Flood Emergency Operation Plan and the Flood Proofing Inspection & Maintenance Plan as described in FEMA Technical Bulletin 3-93.
