Charleston-Arastradero Corridor Project

The City of Palo Alto will be constructing roadway modifications and streetscape improvements to a continuous segment of Arastradero Road and Charleston Road. As part of this project, the City will also be repaving and widening the Los Altos - Hetchy-Hetchy bike path from Arastradero Road to Adobe Creek.

Scope for construction includes the following:

- Construction and landscaping of medians, bulb-outs, and bioretention areas
- Widening of sidewalks and bike paths
- ADA compliant curb ramps
- Traffic signal modifications and upgrades
- Replacement of pavement striping and markings
- Resurfacing Arastradero and Charleston Roads
