Re: Neighborhood Traffic Calming Pilot Project Survey Results


Dear Resident,

Below are the post-installation survey results for the Crescent Park traffic calming project. The survey asked Crescent Park residents to vote yes or no to the permanent installation of the temporary traffic calming measures.

Location 1: Southwood Drive & East Crescent Drive included Curb Extensions and Stop Signs


- 74% of the neighborhood household voted YES to permanently install these calming measures
- **26%** of the neighborhood household voted **NO** to permanently install these calming measures

A review of the survey results in the immediate geographic vicinity of the Project Location 1 also yielded similar results.



Location 2: Hamilton Avenue, Southwood Drive, and Center Drive Survey Result included an Oval-Shaped Traffic Circle

- 78% of the neighborhood households voted YES to a permanent installation of the ovalshaped traffic circle
- 22% of the neighborhood households voted **NO** to a permanent installation of the ovalshaped traffic circle



Next Steps: The Office of Transportation will seek Planning and Transportation Committee review and City Council approval to permanently install these traffic calming measures. Once the City Council approves the measures, staff will seek to initiate the design and seek community feedback and input on the improvement's during the design process.
