Text Messages for Power Outages: CPAU has a new Outage Management System (OMS) which allows us to more quickly detect and respond to power outages and provide customers with timely notifications. Through the OMS, we can now provide CPAU customers with information about power outages through text alerts. To keep customers up to date during an outage event, we have opted-in all mobile numbers on file in our utilities account records.
