PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project is for a new service contract that addresses the processing of residential and commercial solid waste collected within the City of Palo Alto. The project will increase the City's diversion rate for materials placed in the black solid waste containers from 29.68% to 70.45% and result in an additional 7,868 tons/per year of diversion. The project will change where the waste is processed as well as the final landfill location for any residuals. No change to the collection of materials within the City are proposed as part of the project.
